A: **False**

- Q: *In which year did the Spice Girls release 'Wannabe'?*

- Q: *What famous tune does this sheet music show?*

- Q: *Name this instrument.*
A: **Stylaphone**
- Q: *Which English county do Supergrass and Radiohead have in common?*
A: **Oxfordshire** (it's where they were both founded)
- Q: *Who was the youngest Beatle?*
A: **George Harrison**
- Q: *What was Lady GaGa's first Number 1 hit?*
A: **Just Dance**
- Q: *Which British band had a hit with 'Fool's Gold'?*
A: **The Stone Roses**
- Q: *A typical symphony orchestra consists of four groups of related musical instruments. Can you name them?*
A: **Woodwind, Brass, Percussion, Strings**
- Q: *What was the name of Jonny Cash's backing band throughout his career?*
A: **The Tennessee Three**
- Q: *How many black keys does a standard piano have?*
A: **36**
- Q: *Who has had the most UK number 1 singles: Cliff Richard or Madonna?*
A: **Cliff Richard** (14), Madonna (13)
- Q: *What is the more common name for an empty orchestra?*
A: **Karaoke**

In this round you'll see small section of a classic album cover. For each album cover, you'll score $\frac{1}{2}$ point for correctly identifying the album and another $\frac{1}{2}$ point for correctly naming the artist.

However... this is a JEOPARDY ROUND! If you're confident enough to answer all 20 AND you get them all correct, you'll DOUBLE your score on this round to a whopping **40 points!**
